Group 1:

- More direct contribution from service users.
- Building trust.
- 288 people involved – Leaders.
- Action learning.
- Challenge thinking.
- Unpick issues.
- Cross fertilisation.
- Move outside of “silos”
- Currently PMG uses statistics.
- What are problems with delivery – brainstorm solution.
- Be more proactive.
- Need clarity of roles.
- Lead collaboratively and collectively.
- Use array of talent to solve problems.

- More junior group to look at statistics.

Group 2:

- Perspective/being able to change things.
- Recognise if DP's are becoming too silo/challenge if this happens.
- Added value in some places (e.g. good base for monitoring targets)
- SSP relationship with this group – more clarity/power for change/understanding agents.

Looking back:

- § Delivery Partnerships
 - Ø Limited collaboration amongst Delivery Partnerships.
 - Ø PMG impact? Very limited.
 - Ø Increase in partnerships – has caused more silo and less cross over work.
 - Ø Cross cutting themes – a mirage

- § Organisations
 - Ø Effect of Performance Clinics? – focus on information and awareness.
 - Ø Apprenticeships – Follow up? Lack of understanding.

Looking ahead:

- § Consistency of attendance, leadership, team environment – applied to Delivery Partnerships and PMG.
 - Ø Supported by improved communications internally.
- § Engage outside meetings
- § Need different ways of working – e-forums? – teleconferencing?
- § Information management – more focus.
